The mere name of Bordeaux evokes the prestige of its wine-making tradition all around the world.


Famous for its legendary vineyards, iconic Grands crus classés and châteaux, Bordeaux offers an unforgettable experience around the arts of wine.

FURTHER EXCEPTIONAL TREASURES

Within easy reach, enjoy the UNESCO-listed medieval village and surrounding chateaux of Saint-Émilion or the famous "Chateaux Road", winding through most of the region's revered names, from Château Margaux to Mouton Rothschild.

You can also explore the Dordogne Valley's key archaeological sites and Lascaux with its outstanding Prehistoric cave paintings created around 16,000 years BC.

Heading north-east, the Cognac region produces the world's favourite brandy thanks to its leading distilleries, such as Hennessy, Rémy Martin, Camus, Otard, Martell, Courvoisier, and more.

Located a 55-minute drive away from Bordeaux, the Bay of Arcachon is a fascinating world with multiple landscapes: oyster ports, sandy beaches, pine forests, a famous peninsula and the highest dune in Europe.

Its typical towns and villages invite you to discover their many attractions in an enchanting and colourful setting.

The city is ideal for luxury yachts: as soon as you step off the boat, you are in the very heart of the city, along the 18th century landscaped quays.

Bordeaux is one of a handful of destinations worldwide that can offer this convenience, this heritage, and this allure.

- Located in the Chartrons district, the **Ariane Pontoon** is reserved for super yachts and tall ships up to 3,500 tons. **Rent on an exclusive-use basis, offering excellent security and private access.**
- Close to the historic pont de pierre, the **Ponton d'Honneur** is dedicated to prestige ships up to 1,200 tons as well as major events.
- **The Cité du Vin** Pontoon is also suitable for deluxe yachts and offers additional facilities for tenders.
- Along the quays between the Place des Quinconces (one of the largest city squares in Europe) and the Miroir d'Eau (or reflecting pool), four more **cruise line berths** are also available.


